DETAILED DESCRIPTIONS OF THE ACTIVITIES

1. Aahar Utsav

Introduction: Durga puja is the most important festival that we eagerly look forward to all through the year in Bengal. Our beloved city Kolkata turns prettier with light and décor, theme pandels and above all, the unfathomable spirit of her people.

Unfortunately among all the gifts and glitter, there are some left isolated from these festivities. Durga puja is just another day to them as their normal routine. They are born poor, hardly they have chance to eat good food, living in a very primitive conditions hence fortune denies them the right of being an integral part of the festival. They stand as strangers as they watch others rejoicing in the spirit of Durga puja, knowing well that they will never experience those moments.

"AAHAR UTSAV" – is an initiative of feeding those destitute people with royal food one entire day, from the morning to the night along with different cultural programmes to spread love, care and affection within the community. Our one act of kindness can go a long way in creating happiness for these people stuck in a desolate place.





Date of the activity: 21/09/2017

Our objectives: To feed approximately 2500 people four times in a day with the best quality food.

Beneficiaries: They were 800 tribal people (Sabar) from Eastern and western part of Satyadaspur, who have participated and celebrated the biggest AAHAR UTSAB of South 24 parganas district. More over Santhal and another 1700 people from the Satyadaspur area, who belongs to different caste and creeds, enjoyed this event every bit.

Manpower Involved: Our "trusties", volunteers, supporters everybody actively participated at this **AAHAR UTSAB**. There were 70+ people whose head, hand and heart were involved in this event to spread the happiness, love and affection during the festive season.

2. Health Awareness Campaign: (Against Tobacco And Alcohol)

Introduction: Based on our survey, we observed a severe addiction on tobacco and alcohol within the Sabar community, Even a Child at 2or 3yrs consumes " Khaini"(A fermented coarsely cut tobacco leaves).

They did not find any harm into it. However, tobacco is one of the major cause of their death. It is the biggest health threats for them and leads not only human loss but also heavy social and economic costs.

Our activity- We have produced a documentary film in association with PG & SSKM hospitals to raise the awareness of causes and Consequences of tobacco consumption.We often run this documentary in local Adibasi school as well as during our household visits.



3.Free Health Check Up And Medicine Distribution:

Introduction: we have organized a free health check up along with medicine distribution in the month of September in satyadaspur area.

Objective: The objective of the camp was to provide information regarding the diet and diagnose the existing disease and provide free medicines as required. It is our continuous endeavor to provide health care support across all the satyadaspur specially the sabar community.

Our activity: 1. Organised Free Medical checkup.

2. Free medicine distribution.





Diseases identified among Sabar community:

1. Among children – Malnutrition related diseases, skin infection etc.
2. Among Female- Genital diseases, skin infection.
3. Among male- arthritis, severe back and joint pain.

Manpower involved: Our trustees, volunteers, supporters and well supported by doctors (one gynecologist, one pediatrician, and two general medicines) from R.G.KAR Medical College.

4. New Cloth Distribution

Introduction: In Soul, we desire to do something meaningful by providing new cloths to under privilege people, where we pursue our goal of providing one of the basic necessities i.e. clothing to the less-fortunate.

Date of the activity: In the month of September and January.

Our objectives: To give an under privilege person new cloths is as good as dressing them with self- respect. With this objectives we distribute cloths (jacket, sweater, shirts, t-shirt, shares, dress etc.) to children, women and men of all ages who live in poverty.

Manpower involved: Our trustees, volunteers, supporters.

5.Skill Based Training(Through Learning And Earning Model)

Introduction: Women are the most integral part of our society Women tend to transfer improvements in their own lives into the lives of their children, families and communities, but unfortunately Women and girls are disproportionately affected by poverty and discrimination. Lack of education for girls contributes to early marriage, higher birth rates, and lower income. Therefore though this activity it is our honest effort to create awareness among the female villagers of SHIVNAGAR AND RAMGANGA to make them financially independent.

Location: Shivnagar,Banashyamnagar,pathar pratima

Our objective:our goal is to create alternative income opportunities for females to make them self-sufficient and confident.

Our activity:

- 1.We are conducting different workshops for providing different types of skill based training like artificial ornaments designing, beads jewelry designing, origami etc among 100 females.
- 2.we are creating reference market for those families to sell those products for creating alternative income opportunities for females.

Manpower involved:Our trustees, volunteers, Experienced trainers.

6.Aids To The Tiger Victims

Introduction: Five hundred Bengal tigers lived in the world's largest mangrove forest but so do more than a million human, every year tigers attack more than 60 people and only half of them survives, thus nothing strikes more fear into the hearts and minds of the people of the Sundarbans - the vast river delta on the northern shore of the Bay of Bengal - than the word "tiger". Even the mention of this word can send villagers into a blind panic.



Objective: Every now and then these villagers are attacked by the tigers especially when they went for crab collection for their survival. As a result, most of them died due to attack because of lack of proper medical treatment. Our objective is to save if not all but to save a few lives by providing assistance through our medical team in association with SSKM hospital.

Case Study

Name of the Victim- **Gautam Mallik.**

Attacked during- **Crab collection in the month of January.**

Our activity

1. Soul along with the help of local villagers rushes to the spot where they bought the victim.
- 2.Gautam was bleeding immensely as he was attacked in the neck region along with severe

bites across the body; our team brings him to the city by ambulance after primary treatment in sundarban.

1. Gautam was admitted in the Courgen ward of SSKM hospital.
2. Then and there his treatment was started by the doctors.
3. Now Gautam is recovering gradually with the help of the doctors.

2. Soul provide not only some financial help but also help her family to come down to Kolkata for better treatment.

Introduction:

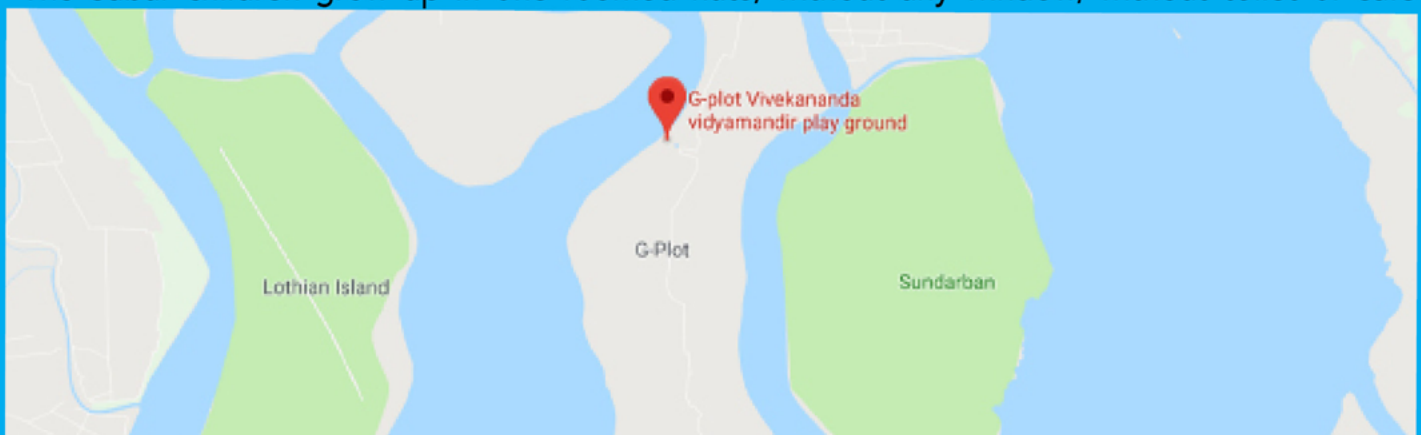
Vidyashram is a venture of SOUL. A separate residential accommodation within the village for Sabar Kids for academic & physical development as well as creates an interest on computers, sports, farming, performing art and Indian mythology etc.

About The Beneficiary Community and Habitants :

The Sabar community is considered as one of the oldest Adivasi (Tribal ethnic population), in eastern India, from the epical time of Mahabharata, now largely inhabiting West Bengal and Jharkhand. The population of Sabar as per 2001 Census was 43,000. It is recorded that the present day Sundarbans in West Bengal shared with Bangladesh has witnessed different human settlements through the ages of time. During British period human settlement was initiated by Sir Daniel Hamilton and people from tribal belt, and the poor in the coastal area of Medinipur migrated in large number to the present day Sundarbans with lure of getting land for cultivation free of cost.

However, Sabar community, as one can see, never went for cultivation ,but bonded Labor for large land holders or zamindars. They worked in exchange of food and clothing, and were not given any separate shelters of home, so, they had to construct their own one roomed little huts with mangrove plants (Hetal tree leaves) as the roof. When they started working for daily wage, they were either given half the rate of normal wage or work free in lieu of food. Gradually, they changed into the forest dependent community, largely collecting mud crabs or honey from the mangrove forests. Sabars always remained deprived due to their ignorance, they were not in a position to avail government aids like House building rather exploited by the various vested people.

The Sabar children grow up in one roomed huts, without any window, without toilet or safe



drinking water and become used to follow the lifestyle of the elderly who often become addicted to either country made liquor or other forms of addiction. The mid-day meal system in the schools failed to attract the Sabar children who preferred to follow their elders and live a life of eternal

As the Sabar community still not in mainstream and unaware of civic society, their children thus remain isolated, deprived from all source of modern human facilities. In this context our project VIDYASHRAM plans to bring if not all but at least 60 children under our fold.

- 2.Resist Child Marriage
- 3.Divertng from current occupation to New occupation of next Generation.
- 4.SOUL wants to improve Sabar's Socio economic condition by creating employability and entrepreneurship through skill base training.
- 5.Creating awareness of agricultural practice suitable for the locality.

6.Spreading awareness against human rights, improvement of health and sanitation specially among women.

7.Gender biased violation.

Overall to return back them into mainstream society.

Specific goals:

1. To motivate them for regular attending government sponsor school.
2. Resist them from becoming addicted.
3. To prevent child marriage.
4. To overcome childhood stunting due to malnourishment.

Our activity:

Vidyashram provides them nutritious food and all healthcare support through proper medical advice from medical practitioners to improve their childhood growth.

Vidyashram ensures regular school attendance, provide support for doing home works, share Vedic knowledge,support on sports and ensure a disciplined cultural ambience.

We will also conduct online classes through Skype. The objective of the online classes-

- Quality training from the best resources in the city areas.
- Foster the leadership.
- Create competitive ambience.
- Fast and effective learning.

As today the necessity of environmental awareness is more demanding and urgent than ever before.

Time of the activity: In the month of October

Location: In uttarakhand (kedarnath)



Our objectives: the objective of this campaign is to spread the awareness among people that cleanliness is next to Godliness. We have observed that after being educated also people throw the litters in their surrounding without understanding the harms of unhygienic condition therefore a small step from an individual can contribute a lot to make out environment clean.

Our activity:

1. We interacted with the local police, pilgrims, and local people and spread the awareness about environmental cleanliness.
2. We did "Clean kedarnath campaign" in the route of KedarnathYatraand collected all the garbage, litters and dumped it to make Kedarnathclean.

Do Well Stay Well Campaign

Introduction: A Physiological grooming session and awareness campaign ,predominantly for the students age 10+.

Location:Across different schools of west Bengal.

Our objective: Our goal is to make them aware about the difficult part of human life in a 30 mins session. We will highlight the livelihoodchallenges of tribal children and make students aware that they enjoy a better life . In our modern society, we observe that there is an increasing demand of smart phones, pocket monies, laptops, game stations etc. And it is imperative to say that such behavior becomes alarming, they adopt some wrong pathlike intoxication, homicidal



tendency, self destructionetc if thing goes against their will, which effects their life as well as their families.It is a cognitive effort from our side to sensitize students about the different life, more precisely tribal life and their difficulties through different brain storming activities. Moreover, we will appeal to the students to come forward in change making drive.
